

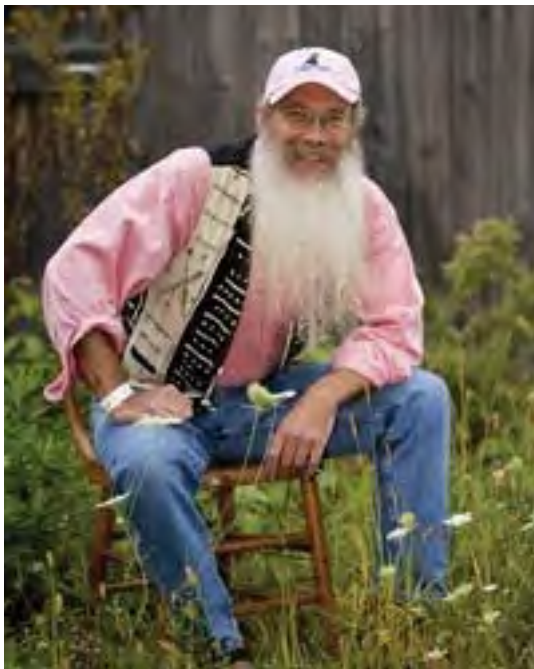
Mt. Washington cultural council 2016 programs
