Recycling

Many of the things you **THINK** are recyclable are not. **Only food or cleaning product stiff-walled containers are permitted** in the roll-offs. **No used coffee cups, straws, hangers, flower pots, plastic bags, bottle caps, flower vases, broken china or children's toys.**

WE WILL NO LONGER ACCEPT SHREDDED PAPER. Shredded paper does not meet the conditions of the MRF contract and is considered to be a contaminant for the mixed paper load. Please put it in a secured plastic bag and put it in the compactor.

We **Cannot** Accept the following items in Mount Washington — even if they are in a plastic bag for the compactor.
